




Q3 What are the three biggest challenges facing your organisation – tick up to 3 that apply -


Q4 What happened to your organisation in 2022? Tick all that apply



Q5 Is is the current cost of living crisis affecting demand for your services? Please select an answer and explain your answer in the box below




